Old Business:



- Shirley/Wilkinson Ambulance Service – Discussion on what to do regarding letter sent from Wilkinson Town Attorney. No decision made regarding what to do with this issue. Recommendations from attorney was for him to check with the Wilkinson town attorney and Andy to get all records from when the service started to provide the numbers of what the Town of Wilkinson has contributed versus the Town of Shirley. Andy also to write out in detail of proposals that he might have.
