**Call to Order:**

Fire – Andy Ebbert Fire Chief – No Report will have 2 reports combined for next meeting

Maintenance – Brian Vaughn

- Mosquito Spray 55 Gallons. Cost \$2483.00. David Messer moved to approve. Becky Perkins second, motion carried. 2-0
- Dead Trees at Illinois and South Street and Alley Quote \$1450. David Messer moved to approve second Becky Perkins, stating that maintenance needs to keep it sprayed in the alley so it does not come back. motion carried 2-0.
- Dump Truck tires – Last quote were Riley Park Tire \$1839.24; Greens Fork \$1806.24 (new quotes were approximately the same) David Messer moved to approve, Becky Perkins second, motion carried 2-0
- Iron Filter roof replace at \$15,250.00. David Messer moved to approve. Becky Perkins second, motion carried 2-0.
- Maintenance has not found many trucks like our old dump truck most are diesel motors and larger beds. Nothing in the 4-wheel drive only a couple with gas motors. The best I can give you is 7,000-1,500. Clerk Treasurer is to advertise in the paper for closed bids. Minimum price of \$2000.
- We have been trying to sell some old lift station pump motors 2 plus months. Can we scrap them? David Messer motioned to scrap the pumps. Second Becky Perkins, motion carried 2-0.

Police – Brian Pryor Police Chief

- Dodge Ram Repair \$552.40 (needs vote) David Messer moved to approve. Becky Perkins second, motion carried. 2-0
- Replace Truck: Police Dept. would like to trade the charger in on a new truck and move Ram to the pool vehicle. The kennel would be moved to the new truck. David Messer would like Police Dept. to look for another Department to purchase the Charger.
- Firearms: I have gotten two (2) quotes for Firearms. TKC Firearms had 15 Firearms for \$12,824.86, Fields Outdoor Adventures, had a quote for \$8,625 for 15 Firearms. David Messer moved to purchase 5 firearms at this time. Possibly purchase more in late Fall. Becky Perkins second, motion carried, 2-0.
- Body Camera: We have purchased all new body cameras for the Police Department with grant money. Short 2 cameras. Will the town purchase the two (2) that are needed? \$549 each for \$1,098? David Messer moved. Becky Perkins second, motion carried, 2-0.
